

Bryan here is the word for Jubilee...

H3104

לְבוֹי לְבוֹי

yôbêl yôbêl yo-bale', yo-bale'

Apparently from H2986; the blast of a horn (from its continuous sound); specifically the signal of the silver trumpets; hence the instrument itself and the festival thus introduced: - jubile, ram's horn, trumpet.

Word search that (**H3104**) in Hebrew and you will see it is used in the book of Joshua...

***Joshua** (the name of Messiah in Hebrew) **6:1-21** Now Jericho was tightly shut because of the sons of Israel; no one went out and no one came in. YHWH said to Joshua, "See, I have given Jericho into your hand, with its king and the valiant warriors. "You shall march around the city, all the men of war circling the city once . You shall do so for six days. (or maybe six thousand years?) Also seven priests shall carry **seven Shofars of JubileeH3104** before the ark; then on the seventh day you shall march around the city seven times, and the priests shall blow the Shofar. "It shall be that when they make a long blast (the seventh blast) with the **Jubilee Shofar H3104**, and when you hear the sound of the shofar, all the people shall **RuahH7321** with a great **TeruahH8643**; and the wall of the city will fall down flat, and the people will go up every man straight ahead." So Joshua the son of Nun called the priests and said to them, "Take up the ark of the covenant, and let seven priests carry seven trumpets of **Jubilee ShofarsH3104** before the ark of YHWH. Then he said to the people, "Go forward, and march around the city, and let the armed men go on before the ark of YHWH." And it was so, that when Joshua had spoken to the people, the seven cohens carrying the seven **Jubilee ShofarsH3104** before YHWH went forward and blew the Shofars; and the ark of the covenant of YHWH followed them. The armed men went before the cohen who blew the Shofar, and the rear guard came after the ark, while they continued to blow the Shofars. But Joshua commanded the people, saying, "You shall not shout nor let your voice be heard nor let a word proceed out of your mouth, until the day I tell you, '**RuahH7321!**' Then you shall **RuahH7321!**" So he had the ark of YHWH taken around the city, circling it once ; then they came into the camp and spent the night in the camp. Now Joshua rose early in the morning, and the cohen took up the ark of YHWH. The seven priests carrying the seven **Jubilee Shofars'H3104** before the ark of YHWH went on continually, and blew the trumpets; and the armed men went before them and the rear guard came after the ark of YHWH, while they continued to blow the Shofar. Thus the second day they marched around the city once and returned to the camp; they did so for six days. Then on the seventh day they rose early at the dawning of the day and marched around the city in the same manner seven times; only on that day they marched around the city seven times. At the seventh time, when the cohen blew the Shofar, Joshua said to the people, "**RuahH7321!** For YHWH has given you the city! "The city shall be under the ban, it and all that is in it belongs to YHWH; only Rahab the harlot and all who are with her in the house shall live, because she hid the messengers whom we sent. "But as for you, only keep yourselves from the things under the ban, so that you do not covet them and take some of the things under the ban, and make the camp of Israel accursed and bring trouble on it. "But all the silver and gold and articles of bronze and iron are holy to YHWH; they shall go into the treasury of YHWH." So the people **RuahH7321**, and cohens blew the Shofars; and when the people heard the sound of the Shofar, the people **RuahH7321** with a great*

TeruahH8643 and the wall fell down flat, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight ahead, and they took the city. They utterly destroyed everything in the city, both man and woman, young and old, and ox and sheep and donkey, with the edge of the sword.

Yom Teruah is the Seventh and final Shofar blast, the great shofar on the great day of YHWH, when he returns and destroys the earth.

Rev 11:15 *The seventh angel sounded his shofar; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become the Kingdom of our Lord and his Messiah, and he will rule forever and ever!"*

2Pe 3:10-13 *However, the Day of the Lord will come "like a thief." On that Day the heavens will disappear with a roar, the elements will melt and disintegrate, and the earth and everything in it will be burned up. Since everything is going to be destroyed like this, what kind of people should you be? You should lead holy and godly lives, as you wait for the Day of God and work to hasten its coming. That Day will bring on the destruction of the heavens by fire, and the elements will melt from the heat; but we, following along with his promise, wait for new heavens and a new earth, in which righteousness will be at home. (See **Psa 46:6 Psa 97:5**)*
