

TO WHOM HAS THE ARM OF YHWH BEEN REVEALED?

Isaiah 53

*Who believes our report? To whom is the **arm of YHWH revealed?** For before him he grew up like a young plant, like a root out of dry ground. He was not well-formed or especially handsome; we saw him, but his appearance did not attract us. People despised and avoided him, a man of pains, well acquainted with illness. Like someone from whom people turn their faces, he was despised; we did not value him. In fact, it was our diseases he bore, our pains from which he suffered; yet we regarded him as punished, stricken and afflicted by Elohim. But he was wounded because of our crimes, crushed because of our sins; the disciplining that makes us whole fell on him, and by his bruises [Or: and in fellowship with him] we are healed. We all, like sheep, went astray; we turned, each one, to his own way; yet **YHWH** laid on him the guilt of all of us. Though mistreated, he was submissive — he did not open his mouth. Like a lamb led to be slaughtered, like a sheep silent before its shearers, he did not open his mouth. After forcible arrest and sentencing, he was taken away; and none of his generation protested his being cut off from the land of the living for the crimes of my people, who deserved the punishment themselves. He was given a grave among the wicked; in his death he was with a rich man. Although he had done no violence and had said nothing deceptive, yet it pleased **YHWH** to crush him with illness, to see if he would present himself as a guilt offering. If he does, he will see his offspring; and he will prolong his days; and at his hand **YHWH's** desire will be accomplished. After this ordeal, he will see satisfaction. "By his knowing [pain and sacrifice], my righteous servant makes many righteous; it is for their sins that he suffers. Therefore I will assign him a share with the great, he will divide the spoil with the mighty, for having exposed himself to death and being counted among the sinners, while actually bearing the sin of many and interceding for the offenders."*

Many anti-missionaries and non believers in the Mashiach say that this verse speaks of Israel, and Israel only, they are only partially right, why? Prophecies have many meanings, almost always more than one! Examples include David prophesize about himself and Yeshua often within the same sentence, "And his name shall be called Immanuel" was speaking of the future son of King Ahaz and also a deeper meaning of the Messiah. The "Tsemach" in scripture refers to Zrubavel governor of Judah, and also a future leader of Israel! How do we know that **Isaiah 53** is about Mashiach Yeshua... ?

John 12:37-44 *Even though he (Yeshua) had performed so many miracles in their presence, they still did not put their trust in him, in order that what Isaiah the prophet had said might be fulfilled, "**YHWH**, who has believed our report? To whom has the **arm of YHWH** been revealed?"(Isa 53:1) The reason they could not believe was — as Isaiah said elsewhere — "He has blinded their eyes and hardened their hearts, so that they do not see with their eyes, understand with their hearts, and do t'shuvah, so that I could heal them."(Isa 32) Isaiah said these things because he saw the Sh'khinah of Yeshua and spoke about him. Nevertheless, many of the leaders did trust in him; but because of the P'rushim they did not say so openly, out of fear of being banned from the synagogue; for they loved praise from other people more than praise from Elohim. Yeshua declared publicly, "Those who put their trust in me are trusting not merely in me, but in the One who sent me. Also those who see me see the One who sent me."*

Acts 8:30-35 *As Philip ran up, he heard the Ethiopian reading from Isaiah the prophet. "Do you understand what you're reading?" he asked. "How can I," he said, "unless someone explains it to me?" And he invited Philip to climb up and sit with him. Now the portion of the Tanakh that he was reading was this: "He was like a sheep led to be slaughtered; like a lamb silent before the shearer, he does not open his mouth (Isa 53:7). He was humiliated and denied justice. Who will tell about his descendants, since his life has been taken from the earth?" The eunuch said to Philip, "Here's my question to you — is the prophet talking*

about himself or someone else?" Then Philip started to speak — beginning with that passage, he went on to tell him the Good News about Yeshua.

***1Peter 2:25** For you used to be like sheep gone astray (**Isa 53:6**), but now you have turned to the Shepherd, who watches over you (Yeshua).*

So if you let scripture interpret scripture **Isaiah 53** is certainly about the Messiah! What I would like to study tonight is "**The Arm of YHWH**" this is a phrase that appears all throughout the Bible, and as **Isaiah 53** states, **it is about the Messiah of Israel**, Yeshua! A couple months back when we studied "Messiah in the Tanakh" it became exceedingly evident that Yeshua is the "arm of **YHWH**" and even more specific he is "**YHWH**'s right hand". Perhaps we will start with a few examples...

***Isa 33:2** YHWH, show us mercy; we have waited for you. Be their **arm** every morning, and our salvation^{H3444Yeshua} in time of trouble.*

***Isa 52:10** YHWH has bared **his holy arm** in the sight of every nation, and all the ends of the earth will see the salvation^{H3444Yeshua} of our Elohim. (See **Isa 11**)*

***Psa 16:11** You make me know the path of life; in your presence is unbounded joy, in **your right hand** eternal delight.*

***Psa 18:35** (18:36) "You give me your shield, which is salvation, **your right hand** holds me up, your humility makes me great.*

***Psa 45:4** In your majesty, succeed, ride on in the cause of truth, meekness and righteousness. May **your right hand** teach you awesome things.*

***Psa 60:4-5** (60:6-7) To those who fear you because of the truth you gave a banner to rally around, (Selah) so that those you love could be rescued; so save **with your right hand**, and answer us!*

***Psa 63:8** my heart clings to you; **your right hand** supports me.*

***Psa 77:7-15** "Will YHWH reject forever? will he never show his favor again? Has his grace permanently disappeared? Is his word to all generations done away? Has Elohim forgotten to be compassionate? Has he in anger withheld his mercy?" (Selah) Then I add, "That's my weakness - [supposing] the **Most High's right hand** could change {So Yeshua didn't change the Torah?}. " So I will remind myself of Yah's doings; yes, I will remember your wonders of old. I will meditate on your work and think about what you have done. Elohim, your way is in holiness. What Elohim is as great as Elohim? You are the Elohim who does wonders, you revealed your strength to the peoples. With **your arm** you redeemed your people, the descendants of Ya`akov and Yosef. (Selah)*

***Psa 80:15-19** Protect what your **right hand** planted, the son you made strong for yourself. It is burned by fire, it is cut down; they perish at your frown of rebuke. Help the man at your **right hand**, the son of man you made strong for yourself. Then we won't turn away from you - if you revive us, we will call on your name.*

YHWH, Elohim of armies, restore us! Make your face shine, and we will be saved. {Re-gathering Israel **Jer 23:27 Hos 8:8-12** we forget His Name and the Torah, and it is restored through Yeshua}

Psa 89:20-34 I have found David my servant and anointed him with my holy oil. **My hand** will always be with him, and **my arm** will give him strength. No enemy will outwit him, no wicked man overcome him. I will crush his foes before him and strike down those who hate him. My faithfulness and grace will be with him; through my name his power will grow. I will put his hand on the sea and his right hand on the rivers. He will call to me, 'You are my father, my Elohim, the Rock of my salvation'^{H3444Yeshua}. I will give him the position of firstborn, the highest of the kings of the earth. I will keep my grace for him forever, and in my covenant be faithful with him. I will establish his dynasty forever, and his throne as long as the heavens last. "If his descendants abandon my Torah and fail to live by my rulings, if they profane my regulations and don't obey my mitzvot, I will punish their disobedience with the rod and their guilt with lashes. But I won't withdraw my grace from him or be false to my faithfulness. I will not profane my covenant or change what my lips have spoken. {the Torah wont change?!}

Psa 108:6 in order that those you love can be rescued; so save with **your right hand**, and answer me!

Psa 138:7 You keep me alive when surrounded by danger; you put out your hand when my enemies rage; with **your right hand** you save me.

Jer 32:17 " **YHWH**, Elohim! You made heaven and earth by your great power and **outstretched arm**; nothing is too hard for you.

Isa 41:10 Don't be afraid, for I am with you; don't be distressed, for I am your Elohim. I give you strength, I give you help, I support you with **my victorious right hand**.

Isa 41:20 Then the people will see and know, together observe and understand that **the hand of YHWH** has done this, that the Holy One of Isra'el created it.

Isa 48:13 **My hand** laid the foundation of the earth, **my right hand** spread out the heavens; when I summoned them, at once they rose into being.

Isa 51:5 My righteousness is at hand, my salvation goes out, **my arms** will judge the peoples. The coastlands are putting their hope in me, trusting in **my arm**. (**Isa 11**)

Speaking of when Israel returns to the land again for the final time...

Isa 62:8 **YHWH** has sworn by **his right hand** and by **his mighty arm**: "Never again will I give your grain to your enemies as food; nor will strangers drink your wine, for which you worked so hard;

Speaking of our current exile...

Lam 2:3-6 In his fierce anger he cut off all the power of Isra'el, withdrew **his protecting right hand** at the approach of the enemy, and blazed up in Ya`akov like a flaming fire devouring everything around it. He bent his bow like an enemy, with **his right hand** set like a foe. He killed all who were pleasant to see. In the tent of the daughter of Tziyon, he poured out his fury like fire. **YHWH** became like an enemy; he

*swallowed up Isra'el, swallowed up all its palaces, and destroyed all its strongholds. For the daughter of Y'hudah he has multiplied mourning and moaning. He wrecked his tabernacle as easily as a garden, destroyed his place of assembly. **YHWH** caused Isra'el to forget designated times and Shabbats. In the heat of his anger he rejected both king and cohen.* (Again Yeshua is synonymous with restoring the feasts/Torah)

Hab 3:4 His brightness is like the sun, rays come forth from **his hand** — that is where his power is concealed.

Acts 2:32-33 Elohim raised up this Yeshua! And we are all witnesses of it! "Moreover, he has been exalted **to the right hand of Elohim**; has received from the Father what he promised, namely, the Ruach HaKodesh; and has poured out this gift, which you are both seeing and hearing.

Deut 33:2 " **YHWH** came from Sinai; from Se`ir he dawned on his people, shone forth from Mount Pa'ran; and with him were myriads of holy ones; at **his right hand** was a fiery law for them. (Yeshua the living Torah) And many more in the Brit Chadesha...

Now with a new view on His "right hand", lets see what Yeshua/**YHWH** did for Israel when he saved them from the depths of Egypt. Also remember that Yeshua and **YHWH** are one, im not crediting Yeshua and discrediting **YHWH**, they are one (**Deut 6:4= Mat 10:40**), im simply crediting them both! Before I studied this I did not realize that Yeshua was there all along!

Exo 3:20 But I will reach out **my hand** and strike Egypt with all my wonders that I will do there. After that, he will let you go.

Exo 6:6 "Therefore, say to the people of Isra'el: 'I am **YHWH**. I will free you from the forced labor of the Egyptians, rescue you from their oppression, and redeem you **with an outstretched arm** and with great judgments.

Exo 15:4-18 Pharaoh's chariots and his army he hurled into the sea. His elite commanders were drowned in the Sea of Suf. The deep waters covered them; they sank to the depths like a stone. **Your right hand, YHWH**, is sublimely powerful; **your right hand, YHWH**, shatters the foe. By your great majesty you bring down your enemies; you send out your wrath to consume them like stubble. With a blast from your nostrils the waters piled up — the waters stood up like a wall, the depths of the sea became firm ground. The enemy said, 'I will pursue and overtake, divide the spoil and gorge myself on them. I will draw my sword; my hand will destroy them.' You blew with your wind, the sea covered them, they sank like lead in the mighty waters. Who is like you, **YHWH**, among the mighty? Who is like you, sublime in holiness, awesome in praises, working wonders? You reached out with **your right hand**: the earth swallowed them. In your love, you led the people you redeemed; in your strength, you guided them to your holy abode. The peoples have heard, and they tremble; anguish takes hold of those living in P'leshet; then the chiefs of Edom are dismayed; trepidation seizes the heads of Mo'av; all those living in Kena'an are melted away. Terror and dread fall on them; by the **might of your arm** they are still as stone until your people pass over, **YHWH**, till the people you purchased pass over. You will bring them in and plant them on the mountain which is your heritage, the place, **YHWH**, that you made your abode, the sanctuary, **YHWH**, which your hands established. **YHWH** will reign forever and ever.

Isa 63:12 who caused **his glorious arm** to go at Moshe's right hand? He divided the water ahead of them, to make himself an eternal name;

The Fire and Cloud...

Exo 14:19-20 Next, the **angel of Elohim***, who was going ahead of the camp of Isra'el, moved away and went behind them; and the **column of cloud** moved away from in front of them and stood behind them. It stationed itself between the camp of Egypt and the camp of Isra'el — there was cloud and darkness here, but light by night there; so that the one did not come near the other all night long.
{*the Malak Elohim in Hebrew} So the "Malak Elohim" is in the cloud...

Exo 23:20 "I am sending an angel ahead of you to guard you on the way and bring you to the place I have prepared. Pay attention to him, listen to what he says (**Mat 17:5**) and do not rebel against him; because he will not forgive any wrongdoing of yours (**Joh 12:49, Joh 14:10 & Joh 14:24**), since my name resides in him. But if you listen to what he says and do everything I tell you, then I will be an enemy to your enemies and a foe to your foes. When my angel goes ahead of you and brings you to the Emori, Hitti, P'rizi, Kena`ani, Hivi and Y'vusi, I will make an end of them.

Exo 33:2 I will send an angel ahead of you; and I will drive out the Kena`ani, Emori, Hitti, P'rizi, Hivi and Y'vusi.

This "Malak Elohim" is in the cloud and is leading them into the land, he guards them, and will defeat the enemies in the land, then David says in the psalms...

Psa 44:3 For not by their own swords did they conquer the land, nor did their own arm give them victory; rather, it was your **right hand, your arm** and the light of your face; because you favored them.

Keys and locks Yeshua/Angel **Rev 1:18 = Rev 20:1-3**

With this in mind, read these scriptures...

Exo 14:24 Just before dawn, **YHWH** looked out on the Egyptian army through the **column of fire and cloud** and threw them into a panic.

Exo 16:10 As Aharon spoke to the whole community of the people of Isra'el, they looked toward the desert; and there before them the glory of **YHWH** appeared **in the cloud**; (who is the Glory of Adonai? It is Yeshua **Php 2:11**)

Exo 19:9 **YHWH** said to Moshe, "See, I am coming to you in a **thick cloud**, so that the people will be able to hear when I speak with you and also to trust in you forever." Moshe had told **YHWH** what the people had said; (Moses and Joshua spoke to the cloud "face to face" **Exo 33:11**)

yet no man can see his face... *Exo 33:23* Then I will remove **my hand**, and you will see my back, but my face is **not to be seen.**" (They were speaking with Yeshua, Yeshua also covered Moses so he could see **YHWH's** back!) (Read **John 14:7-9**)

Exo 24:16 The glory of **YHWH** stayed on Mount Sinai, and **the cloud** covered it for six days. On the seventh day he called to Moshe out of the cloud.

Exo 33:9 Whenever Moshe entered the tent, the **column of cloud** would descend and station itself at the entrance to the tent; and **YHWH** would speak with Moshe. When all the people saw the **column of cloud**

stationed at the entrance to the tent, they would get up and prostrate themselves, each man at his tent door.

Exo 40:36-38 Whenever **the cloud** was taken up from over the tabernacle, the people of Isra'el continued with all their travels. But if **the cloud** was not taken up, then they did not travel onward until the day when it was taken up. For the **cloud of YHWH** was above the tabernacle during the day, and fire was in **[the cloud]** at night, so that all the house of Isra'el could see it throughout all their travels. (**Num 9:18-20**)

Deut 33:26 "Yeshurun (Israel), there is no one like Elohim, riding through the heavens to help you, **riding on the clouds in his majesty**. The Elohim of old is a dwelling-place, with **everlasting arms** beneath. He expelled the enemy before you and he said, 'Destroy!' So Isra'el lives in security; the fountain of Ya`akov (**Zech 12:10-13:1**) is alone in a land of grain and new wine, where the skies drip with dew. Happy are you, Isra'el! "Who is like you, a people saved by **YHWH**, your defender helping you and your sword of triumph? Your enemies will cringe before you, but you will trample down their high places."

Ok at this point, your probably thinking it's a stretch! But Yeshua clearly is the right hand of **YHWH** and if you read the rest of the Tanakhs commentary on the Torah, it becomes more clear!

2Ki 17:36 On the contrary, you are to fear **YHWH**, who brought you out of the land of Egypt with great power and **an outstretched arm**. Worship him, and sacrifice to him.

Psa 74:11-15 Why do you hold back **your hand**? Draw your **right hand** from your coat, and finish them off! Elohim has been my king from earliest times, acting to save throughout all the earth. By your strength you split the sea in two, in the water you smashed sea monsters' heads, you crushed the heads of Livyatan and gave it as food to the creatures of the desert. You cut channels for springs and streams, you dried up rivers that had never failed.

Psa 78:49-72 He sent over them his fierce anger, fury, indignation and trouble, with a company of destroying angels to clear a path for his wrath. He did not spare them from death, but gave them over to the plague, striking all the firstborn in Egypt, the firstfruits of their strength in the tents of Ham. But his own people he led out like sheep, guiding them like a flock in the desert. He led them safely, and they weren't afraid, even when the sea overwhelmed their foes. He brought them to his holy land, to the hill-country won by **his right hand**. He expelled nations before them, apportioned them property to inherit and made Isra'el's tribes live in their tents. Yet they tested El `Elyon and rebelled against him, refusing to obey his instructions. They turned away and were faithless, like their fathers; they were unreliable, like a bow without tension. They provoked him with their high places and made him jealous with their idols. Elohim heard, and he was angry; he came to detest Isra'el completely. He abandoned the tabernacle at Shiloh, the tent he had made where he could live among people. He gave his strength into exile, his pride to the power of the foe. He gave his people over to the sword and grew angry with his own heritage. Fire consumed their young men, their virgins had no wedding-song, their cohanim fell by the sword, and their widows could not weep. Then **YHWH** awoke, as if from sleep, like a warrior shouting for joy from wine. He struck his foes, driving them back and putting them to perpetual shame. Rejecting the tents of Yosef and passing over the tribe of Efrayim, he chose the **tribe of Y'hudah**, Mount Tziyon, which he loved. He built his sanctuary like the heights; like the earth, he made it to last forever. He chose David to be his servant, taking him from the sheep-yards; from tending nursing ewes he brought him to shepherd Ya`akov his people, Isra'el his heritage. With upright heart he shepherded them and guided them with skillful hands.

Acharit-Hayamim (The Last Days)

Lets change gears for a minute and look at the FACTS of Yeshua's coming...

1Th 4:15-17 *When we say this, we base it on the Lord's own word: we who remain alive when the Lord comes will certainly not take precedence over those who have died. For the Lord himself will come down from heaven with a rousing cry, with a call from one of the ruling angels, and with Elohim's shofar; those who died united with the Messiah will be the first to rise; then we who are left still alive will be caught up with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air; and thus we will always be with the Lord.*

2Peter 3:10-13 *However, the Day of the Lord will come "like a thief." On that Day the heavens will disappear with a roar, the elements will melt and disintegrate, and the earth and everything in it will be burned up. Since everything is going to be destroyed like this, what kind of people should you be? You should lead holy and Elohimly lives, as you wait for the Day of Elohim and work to hasten its coming. That Day will bring on the destruction of the heavens by fire, and the elements will melt from the heat; but we, following along with his promise, wait for new heavens and a new earth, in which righteousness will be at home.*

Cor 15:51-54 *Look, I will tell you a secret — not all of us will die! But we will all be changed! It will take but a moment, the blink of an eye, at the final shofar. For the shofar will sound, and the dead will be raised to live forever, and we too will be changed. For this material which can decay must be clothed with imperishability, this which is mortal must be clothed with immortality. When what decays puts on imperishability and what is mortal puts on immortality, then this passage in the Tanakh will be fulfilled: "Death is swallowed up in victory. = Rev 2:11*

Facts of Yeshua's return...

1. **The Dead rise**
2. **We meet him in the air**
3. **Heaven and Earth are destroyed / New Heavens and Earth (New Jerusalem)**

Yeshua will do some of these prophecies mentioned below as the "Arm of YHWH" because His coming is at the end

1Cor 1:8

Psa 89:13-15 *Your arm is mighty, **your hand** is strong, your **right hand** is lifted high. Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne^{*1}; grace and truth attend you. How happy are the people who know the joyful shout^{*2}! They walk in the light of your presence, **YHWH**^{*3}. (^{*1}Eze 1:26, ^{*2}Rev 14:3, ^{*3}Rev 21:3)*

Isa 30:29-33 *Your song will be like one that is sung on a night when a holy feast is kept^{*1}, and your hearts will be happy, as if walking to the sound of the flute, to the mountain of **YHWH**, to the **Rock of Isra'el**. **YHWH** will make his glorious voice heard, and he will reveal **his arm descending** with furious anger in a flaming firestorm, with cloudbursts, tempests and hailstones^{*2}. For **YHWH's** voice will terrify Ashur, as with his scepter he strikes them down. Every sweep of the punishing rod that **YHWH** imposes on him will be to tambourines and lyres, as he brandishes **his arm** against them in battle. For the Tofet fire pit has long been ready, prepared for the king, made large and deep, with plenty of wood and blazing with fire; like a stream of sulfur^{*3}, **YHWH's** breath sets it aflame. (^{*1}Yom Teruah, ^{*2}Rev 19:11, ^{*3}Rev 19:20)*

Psa 21:8-9 ***Your hand** will find all your enemies; **your right hand** will overtake those who hate you. At your appearing, you will make them like a fiery furnace. **YHWH** will swallow them up in his anger; fire will consume them. Read Rev 20:7-10, Isa 51:9 & 2Ch 20:6*

Psa 98:1-9 [A psalm:] Sing a new song to **YHWH**, because he has done wonders. **His right hand, his holy arm** have won him victory. **YHWH** has made known his victory; revealed his vindication in full view of the nations (**Amo 1:8**), remembered his grace and faithfulness to the **house of Isra'el***¹. All the ends of the earth have seen the victory of our Elohim. Shout for joy to **YHWH**, all the earth! Break forth, sing for joy, sing praises! Sing praises to **YHWH** with the lyre, with the lyre and melodious music! With trumpets and the sound of the shofar, shout for joy before the king, **YHWH**! Let the sea roar, and everything in it; the world, and those living in it. Let the floods clap their hands; let the mountains sing together for joy before **YHWH**, for he has come to judge the earth; he will judge the world rightly and the peoples fairly. *¹**Rev 7:4**

Psa 110 [A psalm of David:] **YHWH** says to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand, until I make your enemies your footstool., " **YHWH** will send your powerful scepter out from Tziyon, so that you will rule over your enemies around you. On the day your forces mobilize, your people willingly offer themselves in holy splendors from the womb of the dawn; the dew of your youth is yours. **YHWH** has sworn it, and he will never retract - "You are a cohen forever, to be compared with Malki-Tzedek." **YHWH** at **your right hand** will shatter kings on the day of his anger (**Ezek 39:17 & Rev 19:11-21**). He will pass judgment among the nations, filling it with dead bodies; he will shatter heads throughout an extensive territory. He will drink from a stream as he goes on his way; therefore he will hold his head high.

Psa 118:10-23 The nations all surrounded me {**Joel 3:12 (4:12)**}; in the name of **YHWH** I cut them down. They surrounded me on every side in the name of **YHWH** I cut them down. They surrounded me like bees but were extinguished [as quickly] as a fire in thorns; in the name of **YHWH** I cut them down. You pushed me hard to make me fall, but **YHWH** helped me. Yah is my strength and my song, and he has become my Yeshua. The sound of rejoicing and victory is heard in the tents of the righteous: "**YHWH's right hand** struck powerfully! **YHWH's right hand** is raised in triumph! **YHWH's right hand** struck powerfully!" I will not die; no, I will live and proclaim the great deeds of Yah! Yah disciplined me severely, but did not hand me over to death. Open the gates of righteousness for me; I will enter them and thank Yah. This is the gate of **YHWH**; the righteous can enter it. I am thanking you because you answered me; you became my Yeshua. The very rock that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone! This has come from **YHWH**, So some of these things done by "His right hand" in the **Psalms** are clearly Yeshua the Messiah in the book of **Revelation**, might be done in the "Cloud" just as he did in the Exodus from Egypt. And some of them could be done by him physically in the flesh!

Mat 6:10 May your Kingdom come, your will be done on earth as in heaven. and in our eyes it is amazing.

It took **YHWH** six days to create perfection; on the seventh day he rested. After we sinned it took another six days to get to as close to earthly perfection possible... Yeshua enters Ezekiel's Temple **Ezek 43:2 = Rev 1:15** And just as Yeshua the Rock of Israel watered the Israelites in the desert during the exodus from Egypt (**1Cor 10:4**) Yeshua the "Cornerstone" of the Temple flows out water from underneath the Temple (**Ezek 47:1-12**), this is as close as the Heavenly picture in **Rev 22:1-2**. This should give us a timing on Ezekiel's Temple it will be completed just before the day of rest, the thousand years without satan!

Psa 80:1-3 Shepherd of Isra'el, listen! You who lead Yosef like a flock, you whose throne is on the k'ruvim, shine out! Before Efrayim, Binyamin and M'nasheh, rouse your power; and come to save us. Elohim, restore us! Make your face shine, and we will be saved.

TO WHOM HAS THE ARM OF YHWH BEEN REVEALED?

Yeshua is the Shepherd of Israel **Mat 2:6 & Mic 5**, his throne is on the Mercy seat, as he appears above it (**Lev 16:2**)!
